- 1. Read **John 6:29**; **Acts 19:4**; and **John 14:1**. What difference does the word "in" make in each of these verses? What if they were spoken, written, and read without the word "in"? How does its inclusion help us define biblical faith?
- 2. Read **Luke 18:9-17**. How do the two episodes we have studied over the past two weeks in Luke 18 complement each other? What aspects of this week's study based on the example of children help us understand the proper response of the tax collector and diagnose the wrong response of the Pharisee?
- 3. Read **Philippians 3:4-9**. How does this passage address the popular belief that when it comes to salvation "God helps those who help themselves"?

4. Read **Hebrews 6:17-20**. Explain why biblical faith should result in a confident assurance about our salvation?

5. Read **Hebrews 11:32-34**. How does a confident assurance about our eternal home manifest itself between now and the time we leave this present world?
